

Learning Goals for the Confirmation Year

Students will learn, grow, and live their faith together.

Students will share Bible study and conversation based on one of three focus areas, depending on the trimester of the confirmation year: Small Catechism, Bible, and Living Lutheran.

Students will understand that being a person of faith affects not only one's individual life but the lives of everyone around them.

Students will learn understand what it means to be a Lutheran Christian.

Students will experience faithful conversations with peers as well as adult guides from their congregation.

Students will be free to question and wonder about God and their faith with their peers and adult guides.

- ❖ **Youth Led Worship Participation:** There are usually about 4 opportunities throughout the year.
- ❖ **Houseboats on Lake Shasta:** Every June we take a group up to Lake Shasta for six days on the Lake. You are welcome to be part of this experience every summer. It does a lot to build our confirmation students and community. Please join us for at least one year during your confirmation life.
